
Celebration of the Year of Millets


Wild Life Week Celebration




Event: Environmental Quiz

National Workshop on Bio-Diversity Act, 2002

Event: National Workshop on Bio-Diversity Act, 2002

Date: 18.01.2019 and 19.01.2019

The Enviro Club of Auxilium College, Vellore, Tamil Nadu organized a two-day National workshop on "Biological Diversity Act, 2002" in collaboration with the National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai. India, as a richly diverse subcontinent in fauna and flora, t harbours around 7-8% of all globally recorded species, including over 48,000 species of plants and 96,373 species of animals. This biodiversity of India calls for serious responsibility and accountability, on the part of all citizens, stakeholders, policy-makers, scientists and academicians for the conservation and sustainable use of India's biodiversity. It was with this serious objective in mind that the Enviro Club of Auxilium College, held the workshop to give orientation and awareness to college and school teachers on the provisions of the Biological Diversity Act 2002.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr. B. Meena kumari, Chairperson, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai, who also delivered the keynote address on the topic "Over view of the implementation of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002".

Resource talks and lectures were organised on the first day of the workshop. The lectures delivered were informative and useful. **Dr. Bhavani Shankar, Senior Principal, OMEGA International School, Chennai,** shared the practical experiences of preparing people's Biodiversity registers and environmental sustainability initiatives at the school level.

Dr. C. Thomson Jacob, Consultant, Centre for Biodiversity Policy and Law, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai delivered a presentation on the action plans of the National Biodiversity. He explained about the importance of biodiversity and about the values to be integrated into school and college curriculum. He motivated the students to be involved in the preparation of People's Biodiversity Registers (PBRs) and to start clubs to promote protection of the bio-resources. There were suggestions that Biodiversity-friendly projects can be initiated through clubs for the conservation of local seed varieties, conservation of fish eggs, fingerlings, water-quality monitoring, solid waste management, Green belt development and Biodiversity assessment.

Dr. Narendran, Technical Officer, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai delivered a technical session on the topic "**Intellectual Property Right**". He emphasised the Importance of protection and governance of the bio-resources and applying for patents. He enlightened the participants on the various categories of IPR, the values of genetic resources, methods to protect new and rare plant varieties and the legal frameworks of India for NBA, online application format and procedure for filling the application have been explained.

Dr. Ishwar Poojar, UNEP-GEF ABS Project, Project Manager, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai, delivered a lecture on "Access and Benefit sharing" highlighting the importance of Bioresources and the impact of ABS in India. He highlighted the facts of *Illicium veram* which is extracted from the Chinese star anise which helps in retention as like anti influenza drug for Tamiflu. Another example with *vespamandarinia* which is an Japanese homet which is known as japonica giant which boosts up and influences the athletic performance. He further spoke on animals with the Asee/chicken, fishes with absorbable surgical sutures with the development of species *labeorohita*, *cirrhirusmrigala* and Cosmetics made from the species of *byadagi chilli* for the preparation of lipsticks from Elle and from Bengal gram.

Dr. Andrews, Research Associate, UNEP-GEF ABS Project, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai delivered a presentation on the area "Traditional knowledge". The Importance of documenting Traditional Knowledge and Access and Benefit Sharing, and highlighted the Traditional fermentation products. Traditional medicinal practice of local healer, cataract removal, Putka insect (stingless bee) honey and its value, kidney stone removal using ethno medicinal knowledge were clearly explained.

Ms. P. Kanthi Meenakshi, Legal Wing, National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai delivered a talk on International Environmental Laws. Law of nature and its purpose, sources like treaties, custom, general principles of law, judicial decision were explained. STOCKHOCM to RIO, UNCHE-1972, COCOYOC declaration -1974, World Conservation Strategy-1980, World Commission On Environment and Development (WCED), and the RIO declaration – 1992 were highlighted.

On the second day, a field visit to **Kuppam BMC**, **Andhra Pradesh** was organised for all the participants of the workshop. The team started from the campus at around 7.45 a.m. and reached the Krishnamurthy Foundation. The visit was coordinated by **Dr. V. Srinivasa Rao**, **UNEP GEF Project**, **Andhra Pradesh** and he delivered a lecture on the constitution of BMCs and Preparation of PBRs. **Mr. Krishnamurthy President** and **Mr. Jayapaul**, **Secretary** of **Mandal Region of State level Biodiversity Authority**, **A.P.**

The workshop was successfully completed with the **Valedictory function**, with a motivating speech by **Rev. Dr. (Sr.) Regina Mary R, Principal, Auxilium College, Vellore.** She gave away the certificates to all the participants. Around 125 teaching faculty from various schools and colleges participated in the workshop.

They are cultivating Mango, Coconut, Goa, Lime and all the medicinal plants and also Seemai agathi and Kalyana murungai. 
