

Future through Entrepreneurship

Intellectual property has been gaining increased significance with technological advancement. All technology is intelligent innovation and therefore property of the creator. Especially the rise and spread of artificial intelligence dramatically enhances the value of the innovation and needs to be protected with utmost care.

The Intellectual Property Facilitation Centre for MSMEs of ni-msme had organized a national level virtual seminar on Own Your Future through the Journey of Entrepreneurship, in collaboration with Intellectual Property Rights Cell and Aankulam Business Incubation Centre of Aankulam College from 27th to 29th May 2020. Mr. Ganeshkumar, North Educational Trust was the VMO partner. Dr. Sangeetha Aravindhan V., Assistant Professor of Chemistry (IPR Cell) and Dr. Benish Suresh, Head & Assistant Professor of Business Administration (ABIC) were the co-coordinators of the seminar. The entire seminar was moderated by Mr. Dinesh Gajendran, catalyst and Executive Director, Audacious Dreams Foundation.

The speakers invited on the panel were: Ms. V. Sangeetha, Associate Faculty Member, Registered Patent Agent and Trademark Agent, IPR, Certified TPO Accuser (IQ) India, ni-msme and seminar coordinator; Dr. L. Stanley Abraham, Scientist E, Centre for Ocean Research (IOC) sponsored; IIM'S-EXIC Incubation Centre for Marine Biotechnological Studies, Sathyabama Institute of Science & Technology (Deemed University), Chennai; Mr. Ramangopal, Regional Head, EDI, Bangalore.

Ms. S. Glory Srinivas, Director General, ni-msme inaugurated the seminar. In the inaugural address she highlighted the characteristics of entrepreneurship. She highlighted few legendary names from Tamil Nadu like Bharat Ramo Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam and Smt. M.S. Subbulakshmi. She also quoted the successful examples like Ms. Indira No, Former, CEO, PepsiCo and Mr. Sundar Pichai, CEO, Google to motivate the participants towards entrepreneurship. She explained the Chinese way of manufacturing for the world. She elaborated the benefits of being an entrepreneur especially for girls and the various benefits and schemes offered by the Government to start a business. Further she elaborated on the benefits of being an entrepreneur.

During the technical sessions, Ms. Sangeetha focused on IPR and the importance of securing intellectual property (IP) in the early stages. The session highlighted the various types of IPR, patentable and non-patentable inventions in India, trademark requirements and exceptions, fundamentals of copyright and related rights. She also discussed the NIACP scheme for building awareness on intellectual property rights (IPR) for MSMEs and start-ups and the intellectual property protection scheme initiated under start-up action plan.

Dr. Stanley Abraham gave an in-depth view of patent drafting and filing, the procedures involved and the agencies concerned.

Mr. Ramangopal suggested innovative ideas for starting a business and being successful. The session also dealt with creating value by becoming an entrepreneur.

The response to the seminar was overwhelming. Nearly 882 online participants registered for the event from various colleges across the country. The first 500 participants were accommodated through video conferencing and others through live streaming. The welcome, introduction and vote of thanks for all the sessions were given by Dr. Sangeetha Aravindhan and Dr. Benish Suresh. The seminar was cited as a fruitful experience by the participants. Overall, the seminar appears to have ignited the spark of entrepreneurship in the minds of the student participants.
