

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PARAMARSH SCHEME
PROGRESS REPORT

The mentoring of the mentee institutions by the **Auxilium College (Autonomous)**, Gandhi Nagar, Katpadi, Vellore, Tamil Nadu will be spread across 12 months and is divided into four phases,

- I. Preliminary Assessment**
- II. Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation**
- III. Handholding and**
- IV. Exit Assessment and Guidance**

During the "**Preliminary Assessment**", tentatively scheduled during September to November 2019, the mentee institutions will be assessed on their strengths and weaknesses by the project staff and standing committee members along with the Accreditation Ambassador. This will be carried out through questionnaires and visits to the mentee colleges. Based on the data collected, the standing committee will chalk out special programs for specific institutions if required. By the end of this assessment, the standing committee of the mentor institution is expected to have a fair knowledge on the strengths and weaknesses of the mentee institutions and their preparedness for assessment by NAAC.

The preliminary assessment will be followed by "**Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation**" during December 2019 to February 2020. This will be a very crucial period with emphasize on first motivating the staff and then orienting them towards quality enhancement and quality sustenance in Higher Education in general and in specific on the entire process of accreditation by NAAC. This period will be dotted with many workshops wherein many competent experts in the field of Higher Education will be invited as resource persons. A lot of case studies will be taken up and some of the sessions will be tailored to provide the participants a taste of experiential learning. At the end of this timeline, it is expected that the mentee institutions will have a very clear picture of where they stand in the field of Higher Education in the National as well as Global scenario. Further it is expected that the mentee institutions would have developed a deep desire to excel further and take their institution to greater heights through assessment and accreditation.

The **"Hand Holding"** period will be from March to May 2020. During this period, the mentees will be provided assistance on very specific areas like maintenance of their website, creation of links for NAAC, etc. as and if required by the mentees. This will be a period with an emphasis on one-to-one mentoring. The project staff and standing committee will conduct "Academic and Administrative Audit" for all the mentee institutions and provide them with a precise feedback. A visit of the mentee institutions by the project staff, standing committee and the Accreditation Ambassador will provide them assistance in specific areas as desired by the mentee institution. Towards the end of the timeline, the mentee institutions will be making a presentation on their preparedness and this will be the time for the final tune-up.

The "Exit Assessment and Guidance" will be spread across June to August 2020. During this period, in addition to extending any assistance as required by the mentee institutions, the standing committee members along with the Accreditation Ambassador will visit the mentee institutions and validate all the processes and systems established and provide the institutions with an evaluative report.

All these steps will help the mentee institutions to understand the very crucial and important role teachers play in Nation Building and also the importance of maintaining high quality in all academic transactions in their institutions. We are confident that with these inputs, all the mentee institutions will be ready to take up assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Activities during the different phases:

Preliminary Assessment: (September to November 2019) – 1st Quarter

1. Assessment of systems in place through structured questionnaire – on the 7 criteria of NAAC.
2. Through personal visits to all the colleges – by the project staff and standing committee members and the Accreditation Ambassador.
3. Identifying areas of concern – by the project staff and standing committee members based on data collected by the above two processes.

Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation:(December 2019 to February 2020) – 2nd Quarter

1. Conduct any special programs for specific mentee institution as identified through the preliminary assessment.
2. Orientation of IQAC members and a few senior staff of the mentee colleges on the NAAC process of accreditation, importance of documentation and on structured

documentation – maintaining both hard and soft copies. This workshop will be conducted at the premises of the Mentor College.

3. Workshop on the key aspects of the seven criteria for Assessment by NAAC: this will be for all the faculty of the mentee colleges. Two to three mentee institutions will be grouped together and the workshop will be conducted at three different mentee colleges.
4. Workshop on the importance and innovations in “Teaching, Learning and Evaluation” for all the staff of mentee colleges. To be conducted in two or three mentee institutions grouping neighbouring mentees.

Handholding: (March to May 2020) – 3rd Quarter

1. A workshop for IQAC members and senior staff of the mentee colleges on the maintenance of the institutional website and creation of links to upload documents for NAAC – this workshop will be designed to provide hands-on experience.
2. Academic and Administrative Audit of all the mentee colleges by the members of the standing committee – structured questionnaire. Feedback on areas of concern and suggestions for improvement to be provided to the respective institution within a week of the audit.
3. The project staff and standing committee members will visit the mentee colleges and assist them in their preparation for submitting the online data to NAAC – depending on the needs of the individual institutions, the number of visits will vary.
4. Presentation on the preparedness by the IQAC team of the mentee colleges – at the mentor institution.

Exit Assessment and Guidance:(June to August 2020) – 4th Quarter

1. A visit by a team of project staff, standing committee members and the Accreditation Ambassador to the mentee institutions to show case their progress and suggest ways and means on further improvement.

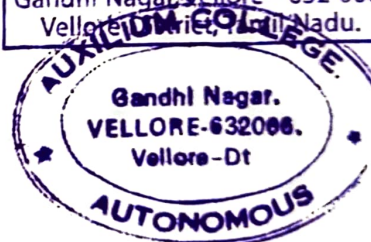

PARAMARSH SCHEME - PLAN DOCUMENT

The mentoring of the mentee institutions by the **Auxilium College (Autonomous)**, Gandhi Nagar, Katpadi, Vellore, Tamil Nadu will be spread across 12 months and is divided into four phases,

- I. **Preliminary Assessment**
- II. **Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation**
- III. **Handholding and**
- IV. **Exit Assessment and Guidance**

During the "**Preliminary Assessment**", tentatively scheduled during September and October 2019, the mentee institutions will be assessed on their strengths and weaknesses by the project staff and standing committee members along with the Accreditation Ambassador. This will be carried out through questionnaires and visits to the mentee colleges. Based on the data collected, the standing committee will chalk out special programs for specific institutions if required. By the end of this assessment, the standing committee of the mentor institution is expected to have a fair knowledge on the strengths and weaknesses of the mentee institutions and their preparedness for assessment by NAAC.

The preliminary assessment will be followed by "**Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation**" during November 2019 to February 2020. This will be a very crucial period with emphasize on first motivating the staff and then orienting them towards quality enhancement and quality sustenance in Higher Education in general and in specific on the entire process of accreditation by NAAC. This period will be dotted with many workshops wherein many competent experts in the field of Higher Education will be invited as resource persons. A lot of case studies will be taken up and some of the sessions will be tailored to provide the participants a taste of experiential learning. At the end of this timeline, it is expected that the mentee institutions will have a very clear picture of where they stand in the field of Higher Education in the National as well as Global scenario. Further it is expected that the mentee institutions would have developed a deep desire to excel further and take their institution to greater heights through assessment and accreditation.

The "Hand Holding" period will be from March to May 2020. During this period, the mentees will be provided assistance on very specific areas like maintenance of their website, creation of links for NAAC, etc. as and if required by the mentees. This will be a period with an emphasis on one-to-one mentoring. The project staff and standing committee will conduct "Academic and Administrative Audit" for all the mentee institutions and provide them with a precise feedback. A visit of the mentee institutions by the project staff, standing committee and the Accreditation Ambassador will provide them assistance in specific areas as desired by the mentee institution. Towards the end of the timeline, the mentee institutions will be making a presentation on their preparedness and this will be the time for the final tune-up.

The "Exit Assessment and Guidance" will be spread across June to July 2020. During this period, in addition to extending any assistance as required by the mentee institutions, the standing committee members along with the Accreditation Ambassador will visit the mentee institutions and validate all the processes and systems established and provide the institutions with an evaluative report.

All these steps will help the mentee institutions to understand the very crucial and important role teachers play in Nation Building and also the importance of maintaining high quality in all academic transactions in their institutions. We are confident that with these inputs, all the mentee institutions will be ready to take up assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Activities during the different phases:

Preliminary Assessment: (September to October 2019)

1. Assessment of systems in place through structured questionnaire – on the 7 criteria of NAAC.
2. Through personal visits to all the colleges – by the project staff and standing committee members and the Accreditation Ambassador.
3. Identifying areas of concern – by the project staff and standing committee members based on data collected by the above two processes.

Motivation, Orientation and Consolidation: (November 2019 to February 2020)

1. Conduct any special programs for specific mentee institution as identified through the preliminary assessment.

2. Orientation of IQAC members and a few senior staff of the mentee colleges on the NAAC process of accreditation, importance of documentation and on structured documentation - maintaining both hard and soft copies. This workshop will be conducted at the premises of the Mentor College.
3. Workshop on the key aspects of the seven criteria for Assessment by NAAC: this will be for all the faculty of the mentee colleges. Two to three mentee institutions will be grouped together and the workshop will be conducted at three different mentee colleges.
4. Workshop on the importance and innovations in "Teaching, Learning and Evaluation" for all the staff of mentee colleges. To be conducted in two or three mentee institutions grouping neighbouring mentees.

Handholding: (March to May 2020)

1. A workshop for IQAC members and senior staff of the mentee colleges on the maintenance of the institutional website and creation of links to upload documents for NAAC - this workshop will be designed to provide hands-on experience.
2. Academic and Administrative Audit of all the mentee colleges by the members of the standing committee - structured questionnaire. Feedback on areas of concern and suggestions for improvement to be provided to the respective institution within a week of the audit.
3. The project staff and standing committee members will visit the mentee colleges and assist them in their preparation for submitting the online data to NAAC - depending on the needs of the individual institutions, the number of visits will vary.
4. Presentation on the preparedness by the IQAC team of the mentee colleges - at the mentor institution.

Exit Assessment and Guidance: (June to July 2020)

1. A visit by a team of project staff, standing committee members and the Accreditation Ambassador to the mentee institutions to show case their progress and suggest ways and means on further improvement.
