



Title: Personality development programme

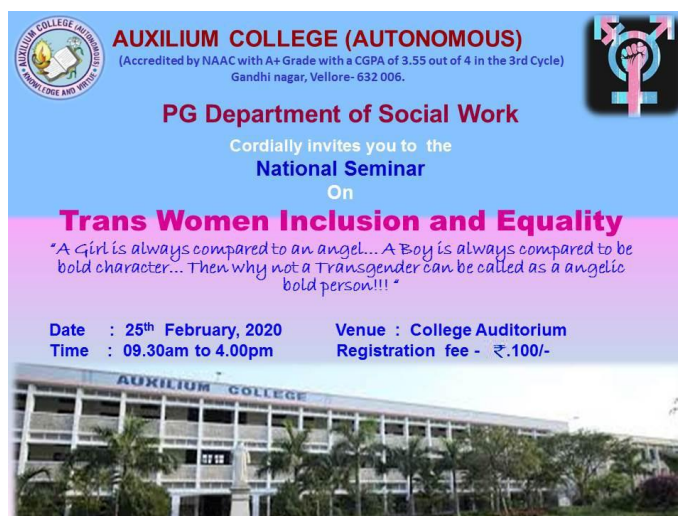
Date:28/01/2020
