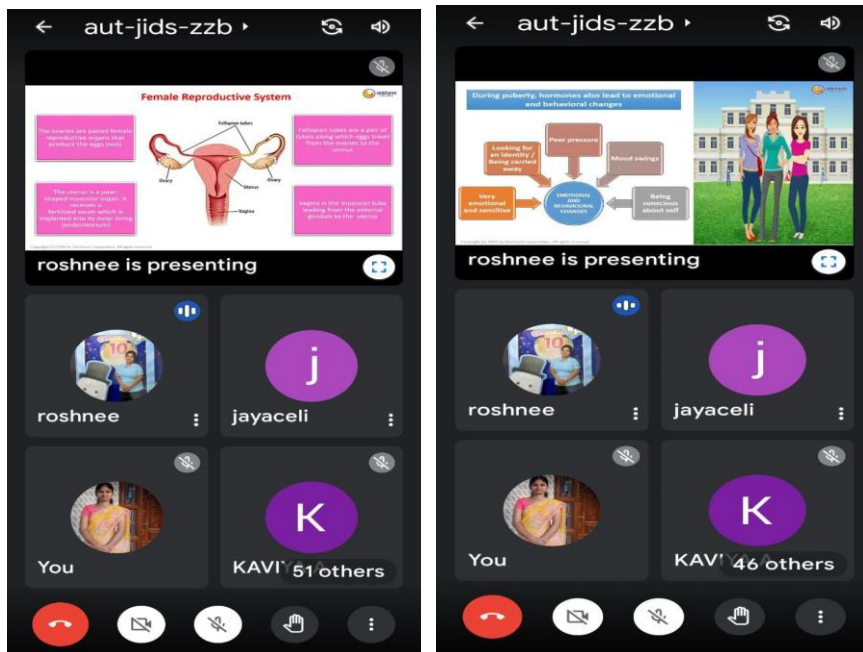
many lighter moments with them wherein they sang songs, performed dance numbers and even distributed gifts. It was truly a memorable and humbling experience for our students.
