



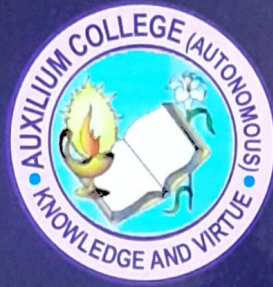

### COE Report

Adhering to the UGC guidelines, Auxilium College (Autonomous) adopted Outcome Based Education in the year 2020-21. Relentless efforts were taken to impart knowledge regarding OBE to the newly appointed staff of the academic year 20-22. A workshop was organized on Outcome-based Education with emphasis on CO, PO, PSO, and Bloom's taxonomy by Dr. Rosaline Ezhilarasi J. Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry.
