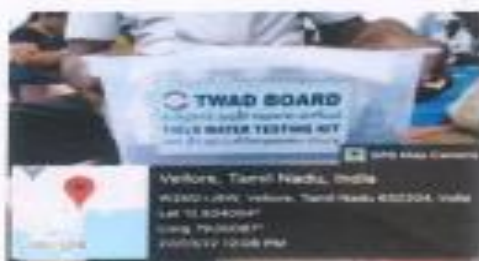

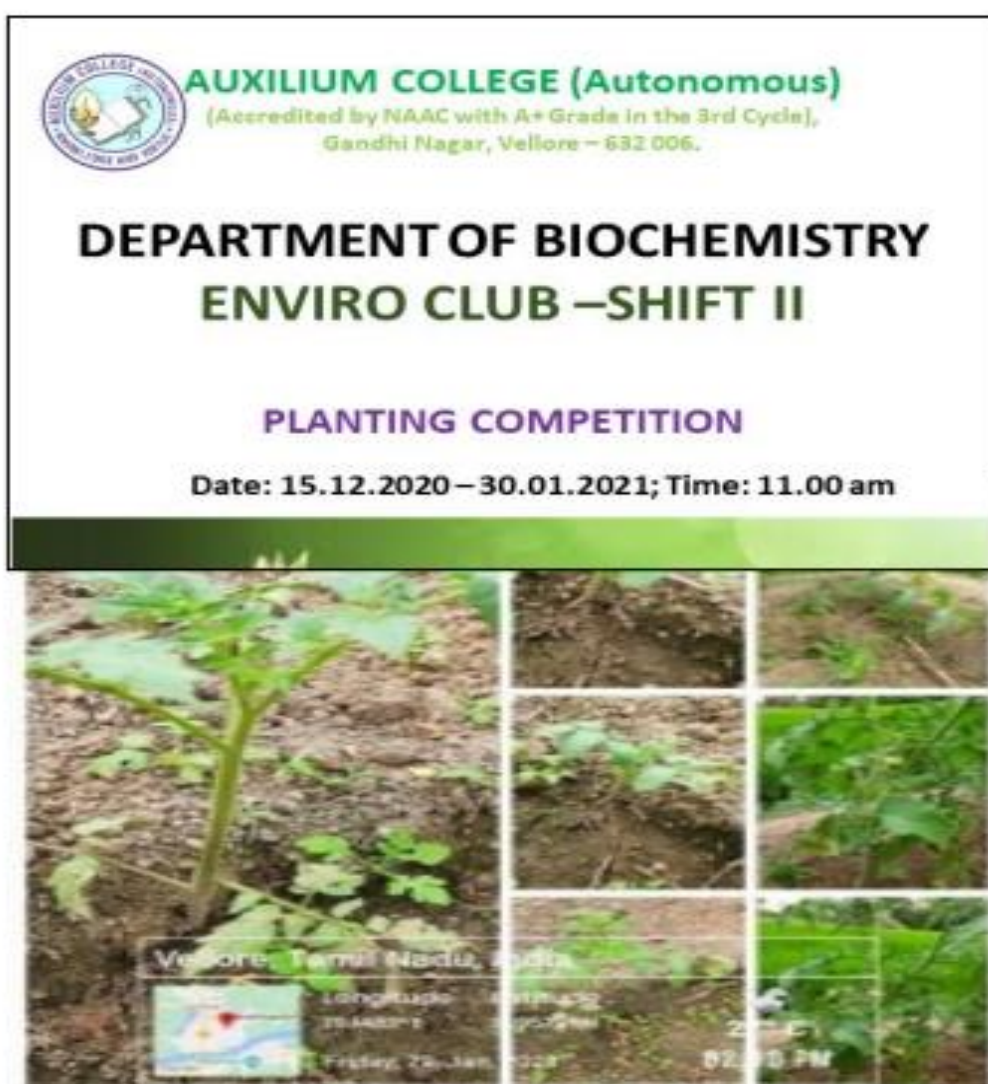
Planting Competition

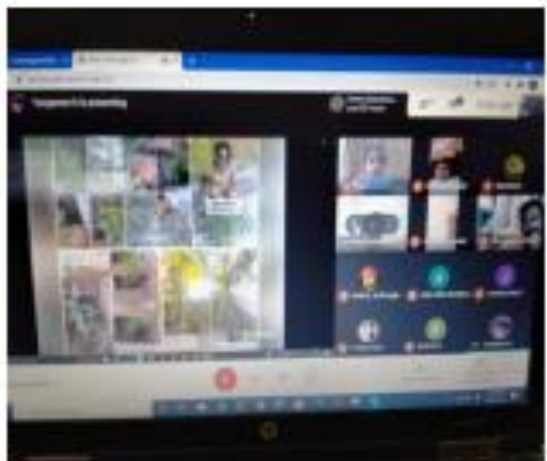

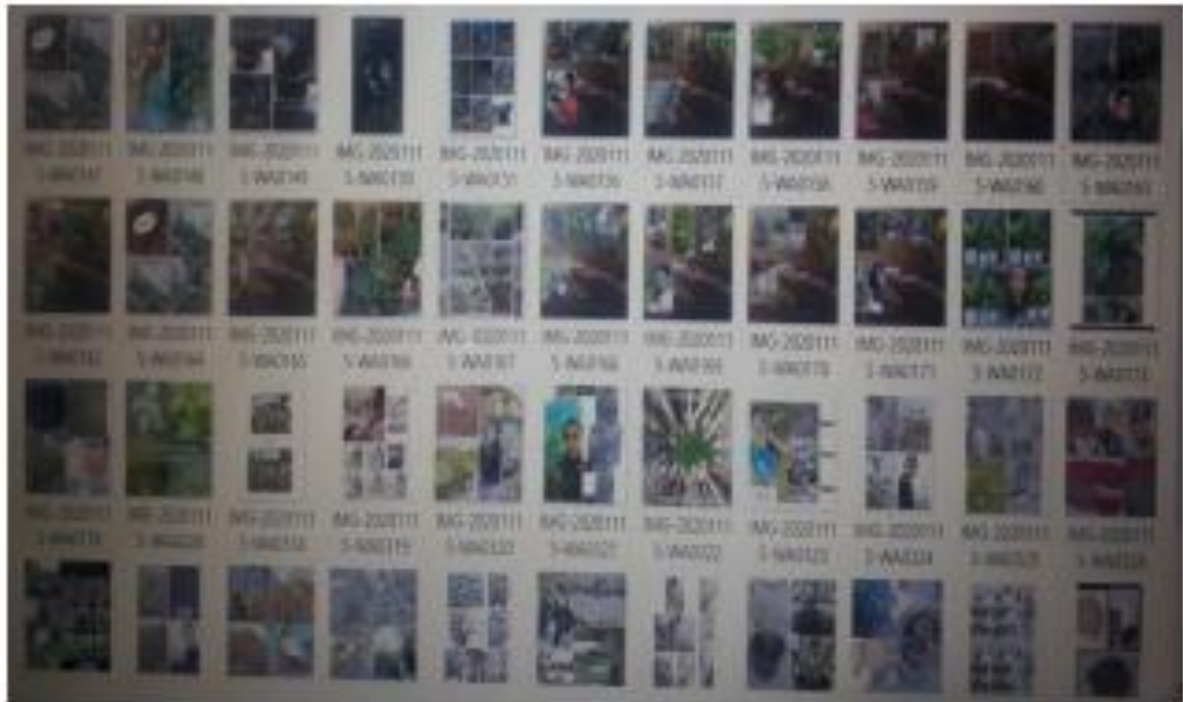

hood," she said. The project was targeted to reach 100 and involve students on environmental issues, added Anantha.

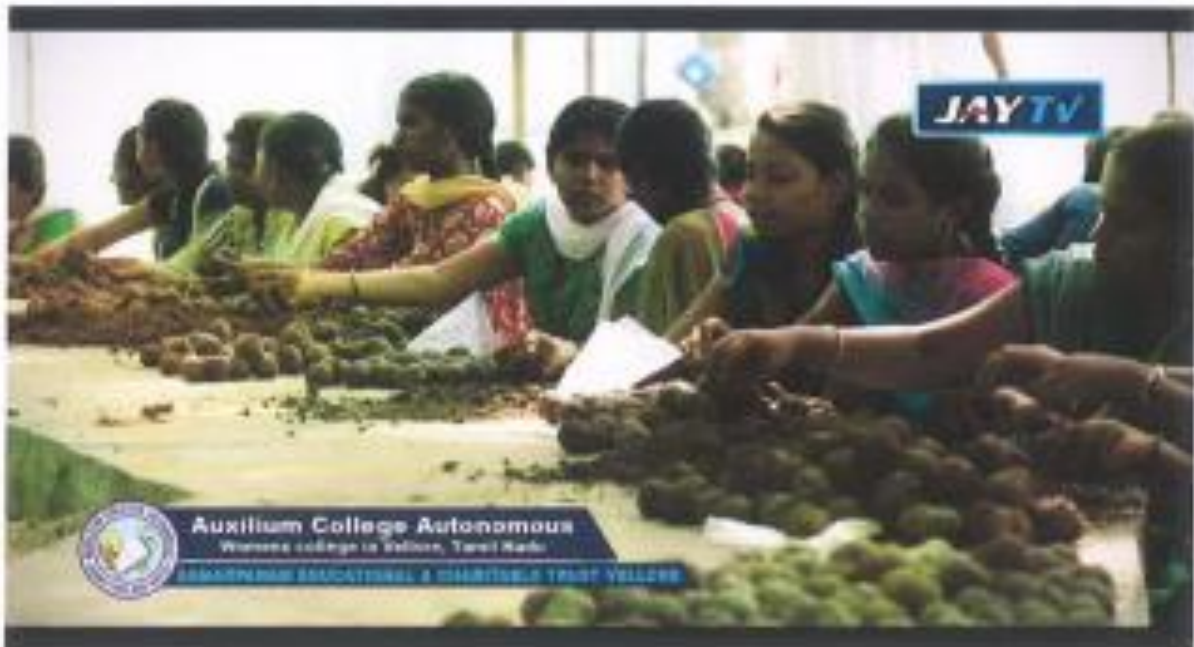
