




International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction- 2021-YRC-10.10.2021


World Suicide Prevention -2021 YRC-10.09.2021-12.09.2021


International Youth Day -2020 YRC-23.11.2020


Fit India Movement NCC-28.08.2020
