

The ENVIRO CLUB has conducted a Workshop titled "Organic farming to promote women Agripreneur" on 11th December, 2019 in collaboration with Arivu Thottam Organic Farm, Kalambattu, Latteri, Vellore. The programme was organized at Arivu Thottam. Sixty seven students from various departments of Shift I and II participated in the workshop with enthusiasm and had a hands-on experience about the best methods of Organic farming and entrepreneurial skills. The workshop started with the farm walk at 9.30 am to 10.00am. Students gained knowledge about different types of crops and its cultivation practices.

Mr.K. Senthamil Selvan spoke on the scope of agri based enterprises in Vellore. He motivated the students on significant number of careers globally from livestock, organic farming and food production. Mr. Rajesh. M took over the next session. He motivated the youth on uplifting the entrepreneurial skills among youth. Mr.A.Srinivasan provoked the youth about the decorative benefits of roof plantings, architectural enhancement and recreational opportunities. He explained about green roof, hydrophonics and container garden. Mrs. C.Devi explained about how an enhancement can be given to products or service before offering it to the customers. She made the students to realize the maximum production at the farm level both crop and livestock and ensured a safe environment that leads to maximum profits. She insisted that value added products are worthwhile investment that can generate higher returns, create brand identity and develop brand loyalty. She also showed some value added products like herbal bath powder, herbal tooth powder and milk products like ghee, butter etc.,

Mr.R.Sivasankaran demonstrated the organic manure preparation and insisted to maintain soil fertility and increase the nutrient level of the soil. Mr. V. Jaya Kumar shared his views about dairy unit and poultry unit. He explained regarding the raising of domesticated birds such as chickens, turkeys, ducks and geese for the purpose of farming meat or eggs for food while dairy farming as a class of agricultural enterprise which focuses on long term production of milk. The programme ended with the distribution of certificates.
