

Rev. Sr. Ivon Goulart Lopes, the Coordinator – (ISS – FMA) Salesian Sisters Generalate, Rome Itlay, felicitated this webinar encouraging everyone to adopt a "**More integral and Integrating Vision**". Rev. Sr. Sumathi M., Head and Assistant Professor of History, Auxilium College took over the session II on the Topic: **Impact of Fraternity and Social Friendship in Higher Education**. She presented the apt document "Fratelli Tutti" at this time of need, in glimpse telling that Life exists where there is bonding, communion, and fraternity and life is stronger than death when it is built on true relationships and bonds of fidelity.
