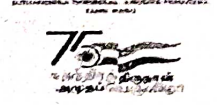



6. Remuneration prescribed by the University should be paid;

7. The other conditions prescribed by the University should be fulfilled (copy enclosed),

8. Sufficient accommodation should be made available;

9. Facilities should be made for the conduct of University Examinations;

10. The maximum number of students that may be admitted to the course should not exceed ~~the~~^{the} ~~number of~~^{total} ~~seats~~^{available}.

11. Such other conditions prescribed from time to time by the University should also be fulfilled;

12. If the conditions of provisional permission granted are not complied with, Statute 44-A of Chapter XXVI of the Laws of the ~~United~~ University Calendar, Volume-I, 1985 would automatically be enforced;

As regards the ~~maxi~~ mode of payment of Rs.1,00,000/- being the endowment to be paid by the management, the same ~~may be~~ will be intimated to the management as soon as a decision is taken by the Syndicate in the matter.

I am also to inform you that provisional permission is granted in B.Sc. Computer Science, in the evening college, for the academic year 1991-92 only and the same will not be extended further.

(i.e. for the academic year 1992-93) until and unless all the above conditions (i.e. Sl.Nos. 1 to 11) are satisfied in full. If the conditions are not fulfilled by the end of 1991-92, as per conditions No.12, the provisional permission will cease automatically and will not be extended for the next academic year (i.e. for 1992-93).

This provisional permission x is granted subject to the ratification of the Syndicate.

A copy of guidelines stipulated by the University with regard to infrastructure required for conducting the B.Sc. Computer Scier Course and qualifications for teaching staff is enclosed herewith for implementation.

It may please be noted that the admission of candidates into I year I of the B.Sc. Computer Science Course (Evening) should be made on or before 16-9-1991, subject to the condition that the candidates so admitted should earn the necessary attendance prescribed for the University Examination.
