(Additional Section) course(s) in the **Evening College (Shift – II)** under unaided pattern only for the academic year 2023-2024 and subject to the condition that the students admitted should earn the required percentage of attendance prescribed to appear for the First Semester Examination and to the fulfillment of usual conditions of affiliation.

The College may select Allied and Elective subjects for the above mentioned course(s) and intimate the same to the *Controller of Examinations* as early as possible for approval.

CONDITIONS OF AFFILIATION TO A COLLEGE / COURSE (ARTS AND SCIENCE) EVENING COLLEGE

- 1. The College shall implement each and every one of the recommendations of the Inspection commission.
- 2. The classroom shall be according to the suggested U.G.C. norms.

- 3. The library should be strengthened as suggested by the Inspection commission. The library shall have common reading room and stack room as per standard prescribed by the U.G.C. / Government.
- 4. As per the UGC Regulations 2018, teachers should be qualified with NET/ SET/Ph.D.
- 5. The teacher should be paid as per pay scales of UGC pay commission of the State Government, as the case may be, and their salary should be made through Banks only. This will be verified by the authorities from time to time.
